The Klakamp and Bauer scholarships are available to graduating seniors of Seymour High School providing a four-year renewable scholarship for tuition plus a \$1,000 per year stipend which can be used for any school expense. The Owen scholarship provides the same tuition benefits, but is available only to Jackson County students attending Purdue University majoring in Civil, Mechanical or Chemical Engineering. Currently, each scholarship has an annual value of \$11,388, and will provide up to \$45,552 over four years.

**Taylor Seniors** and **Rene Clemente** received a scholarship from the **Maurice & May Spray First-Generation Scholarship**, which established by Edward Spray in 2021. Ms. Seniors plans to attend Indiana University-Indianapolis to major in Nursing and plans to become an R.N. Mr. Clemente also plans to attend Indiana University-Indianapolis and major in Nursing. He plans to become a pediatric nurse practitioner. The Spray fund provides reoccurring yearly scholarships of up to \$2,000 to first-in-their-generation graduating seniors of Seymour High School. A senior must also be a current resident of Jackson County and be the first person in their family whose biological parents, siblings, or grandparents did not complete a four-year college degree.
